**Follow the General guidelines**

1. Please join the quiz only when the screen displays **“THE GAME HAS BEGUN”**. If you refresh the page before the quiz starts, you will be limited to three attempts, after which you will not be able to participate. Kindly wait for the official start time, **5:00 PM on 16.05.2026**, before joining.
2. Participants must log in to <https://wayground.com> using their similar email and other credentials provided to NAAS YUVA while registering the event and are advised to join at least 5 minutes before the scheduled time to avoid last-minute technical issues.



3. The quiz will be conducted in online mode and will consist of 50 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs), each having only one correct answer.
4. The total duration of the quiz will be 30 minutes, and starts at 5.00 PM sharp and ends at 5.30 PM automatically.
5. Each correct answer will carry marks as per the evaluation scheme. Faster and more accurate responses will improve overall ranking.
6. Each participant is allowed only one attempt, and all questions must be answered within the allotted time. Unanswered questions will be treated accordingly during evaluation.
7. Participants must ensure a stable internet connection and use a reliable device such as a desktop or laptop with an updated browser. **Refreshing or closing the browser during the quiz may lead to disqualification or run out of attempts.**
8. The quiz must be attempted individually. Any use of unfair means, external assistance, or multiple logins will result in disqualification. The organizing committee reserves the right to review and invalidate suspicious attempts.
9. The results will be prepared based on accuracy and completion time. **Only, shortlisted candidates will be informed about subsequent rounds of the selection process and results are announced in NAAS website.**
